Advent Bible Verses: Scriptures to Read During Advent

Spending time with Scripture is important to our prayer lives during all liturgical seasons.

These simple Bible verses resonate during Advent:

- **Isaiah 40:3:** "A voice of one calling: "In the wilderness prepare the way for the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God."
- Isaiah 30:18: "Truly, the Lord is waiting to be gracious to you, truly, he shall rise to show you mercy; For the Lord is a God of justice: happy are all who wait for him!"
- Hebrews 6:15: "And so, after patient waiting, he obtained the promise."
- Luke 1: 34-38: "But Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" And the angel said to her in reply, "The holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God."
