

COME, EAT AND DRINK

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, even as we have celebrated it already. This we did on Holy Thursday, as we recalled the occasion when Jesus gathered his closest friends for what would be his last meal with them. The Gospels tells us that Jesus was regularly at meals with a variety of people: Pharisees, men and women, the poor and the despised. We are all aware of the importance of meals, meals with family and friends, celebratory meals for special occasions. We are also well aware of how we have missed such opportunities during the enforced lock-down.

Thanks to technologies such as emails, telephones, face-time and zoom, people have been able to keep in touch with relatives and friends, but this has been well recognised as very much second-best, a long way from being able to see each other physically. This technology has also been used by churches. Many priests decided to live-stream the Eucharist, which members of their congregation would view from the privacy of their homes. While these occasions serve as great opportunities to unite people in prayer, yet there is more needed when it comes to celebrating the Eucharist. A live-streamed Eucharist lacks reality. Just as a grandmother is delighted to 'meet' her grandchildren on face-time, what she really desires to do is to be able to wrap her arms around them, to hug them and kiss them.

One of the two essential elements which are missing from such Eucharists is the presence of people, a congregation. We do not take part in a Eucharist as individuals who desire to satisfy a 'need' or who wish to obey a directive from the Church. The Eucharist is essentially a community event in which all present are invited to take part, to be active participants. Sadly, the added impression which a live-stream Eucharist can create is that the only person needed is the priest.

The second essential element is the opportunity to receive Communion. We recall that at the Last Supper Jesus took a loaf of bread, broke it and gave it to his friends inviting them to eat of it; that he later took a cup of wine and invited them to drink of it. For us not to eat of the bread and drink of the wine would be to miss out on what is essential; similar to joining family or friends at a meal, and not eating from what is provided. While there will always be need to live-stream the Eucharist, it would be very sad if it was adopted as an ordinary alternative.
