PROCLAIMING THE GOOD NEWS

Leonardo da Vinci was working on a large canvas, sketching here, painting there over a period of time, until one day he decided to stop altogether. He called one of his more gifted students, stood him in front of the unfinished canvas and challenged him, "I would like you to complete this painting." The horrified student protested that he was both unable and unworthy to complete such a great work which his master had begun. But his master silenced him. "Will not what I have done so far inspire you to do your best?" Jesus, our Lord and Master began to spread the Good News two thousand years ago by what he said, by what he did, and particularly by what he suffered. Like Leonardo, Jesus gave us his message in large strokes, and left it to us to continue what he had begun.

The Feast of the Ascension might not arouse as much interest in us as either one of its more popular 'cousins': Easter and Pentecost. It might, on the other hand maintain an enduring presence in us as our Lord and particularly as our Master after, mission accomplished he returned to the Father where one day we too will go to inherit the place which has been prepared for us since the beginning of time. It was actually on the eve of his departure that, gathering his disciples around him he impressed on them the urgency of taking his message to the whole world. "Go into the whole world," he instructed them, "and proclaim the good news to the whole nation. Go to all peoples everywhere, and make them my disciples..." And even though there have been some shocking and tragic events along the way, we have still been able to proclaim the saving love of Christ far and wide. Statistics would affirm that Christians are, at least nominally, the largest religion in the world. Meanwhile it is comforting to remember that Jesus has not abandoned us, but that he continues to remain with us, just as he promised.

Loving God, we pray: for new mothers, coming to terms with new responsibility; for expectant mothers, wondering and waiting; for those who are tired, stressed or depressed; for those who struggle to balance the tasks of work and family; for those who are unable to feed their children due to poverty; for those whose children have physical, mental or emotional disabilities; for those who raise children on their own; for those who raise children on their own; for those who care for the children of others; for those whose children have left home; and for those whose desire to be a mother has not been fulfilled.
