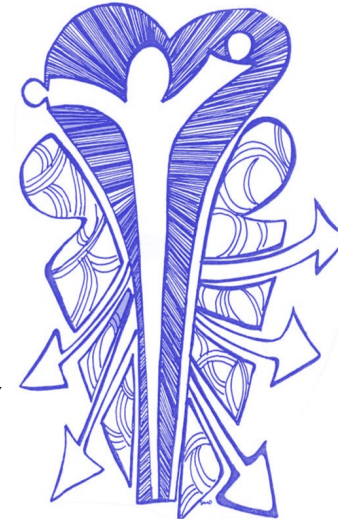
IMPORTANT NOTICE

**Remembrance Day
November 11th**

At 11am on the 11 November 1919, Australians, for the first time, observed one minutes silence in tribute to the men and women who died on battlefields in the Middle East, Gallipoli and Europe.

In 1997 the Governor-General issued a Proclamation urging all Australians to observe the one minute silence on Remembrance Day. This tradition continues, to ensure the deeds of all who died, or suffered in wars are never forgotten.

The Ancient Greeks believed that rosemary made their memories stronger. On this day, many people wear sprigs of rosemary as a symbol of remembrance for those who have died in wars.
