EXPLORING THE WORD A little-noticed phrase in this text adds significantly to the way we understand this story. Jesus, told the disciples to cross to the other side of the lake. In doing this, they were heading away from the Jewish region and into Gentile territory. The boat is a symbol of the church and, as such, we can detect in this text a reflection of the situation of Matthew's community who have been forced out of the synagogue and away from traditional Judaism. More and more, it is Gentiles who are coming to believe in Jesus. This is causing fear and concern for some in the community.

This text offers a parable of the Church besieged, and being tossed about. Peter's response is to be bold and step out into the unknown yet he is vulnerable. The great comfort is in the Risen Lord stretching out his hand to restore morale. This manifestation of the power of Christ is greeted by the great acclamation of faith: *Truly, you are the Son of God.*

Visitors to the Holy Land like to take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, the sea on which Jesus walked. A certain tourist wanted such a ride and the boatman told him the fare was fifty dollars. "Fifty dollars!" exclaimed the tourist, "No wonder Jesus walked!"

A proper understanding of the Gospel story of Jesus walking on the sea has a lot to teach us about who Jesus is. This story, together with the one about the multiplication of the loaves and fishes which we read last Sunday, shows us that Jesus is Lord and has authority over all forces natural and supernatural.
