IT IS EASY TO SAY "I LOVE YOU", BUT THE PROOF IS IN THE DOING!

We all know very well, that talk is cheap, and mere words are without meaning unless our words are expressed in deeds. Love is not simply a nice feeling, a sentiment, a warm emotion. Affection is a feeling. Love becomes real in decisions made and in the actions that follow. It is in activity that love is realised.

Of course, words are important. The three magical words, "I love you" can be the most beautiful and powerful words for a person. It is vital for parents and children, to actually say, "I love you", to each other. They can make such a positive difference to our well-being!

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that we show our love to Him by obeying the Commandments, and that we will be loved by "the Father."

Pope Francis' Five Finger Prayer

The thumb is the closest finger to you. So start praying for those closest to you. They are the persons easiest to remember.

The next finger is the index. Pray for those who teach you, instruct you and heal you. They need the support and wisdom to show directions to others. Always keep them in your prayers.

The following finger is the tallest. It reminds us of our leaders, the governors and those who have authority. They need God's guidance.

The fourth finger is the ring finger. Even though it may surprise you, it is our weakest finger. It should remind us to pray for the weakest, the sick or those plagued by problems. They need your prayers.

And finally we have our smallest finger. The smallest of all. Your pinkie should remind you to pray for yourself. When you are done praying for the other four groups, you will be able to see your own needs but in the proper perspective and also you will be able to pray for your own needs in a better way.
