WHO ARE YOU?

Just as the liturgical season of Lent is a time given to us as an intense preparation of Easter, so too Advent is a time for us to reflect on how we witness the birth of Jesus among us. While in the past the season of Lent requires us to undertake some serious work of penance and abstinence, Advent wasn't quite as demanding. Today, neither Lent nor Advent make any such demands, inviting us, instead to reflect on how we witness to the love of God.

Today's Gospel does no look back on the birth of Jesus. It fast-forwards thirty years instead, when Jesus is about to begin his ministry. There might not have been anyone to announce his birth some thirty years earlier, but God had provided a very worthy messenger to announce the arrive of the Messiah and the beginning of his mission. As John settles around the shores of the Jordan and invites people to be baptised as a way to show that they wished to change their ways, people flock to him in large numbers. Among those are also some of the leaders of the Jews, who are curious as well as interested in finding out who John is, and why he is offering baptism to those who ask for it.

"Who are you?" they asked him, to which John immediately gave a definitive answer: "I am not the Christ," I am not the promised Messiah. "Who are you then?" the Priests and Levites asked, "are you Elijah, or the Prophet?" For his answer, John refers to the prophet Isaiah: "I am a voice that cries in the wilderness. Make a straight way for the Lord."

With this answer, John seemed to disappear from the scene, as though there was no further role for him in the scheme of things. It would be Jesus, however who would tell us, one day just how important John had been, and how important his role had been in God's Plan of Salvation: "of all men born of a woman, there is no on greater than John."
