THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN

The focus of Jesus' teaching in the Gospel of Matthew has, so far been the Kingdom of Heaven. The sick are cured, the lame walk, the deaf hear, the blind see, cleanse the leper, raise the dead, cast out devils. His teaching has been directed to crowds in general or to particular groups which are called 'Disciples'. Today Jesus chooses twelve from this group, names them and refers to them as Apostles. It is largely believed that the word 'Apostle' is a New Testament continuity of the notion of the Twelve Tribes of Israel, caring for their people. Today it is to these, the newly chosen Apostles that Jesus entrusts his mission, "Proclaim that the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." And what are they to actually do? They are to continue Jesus' work, "cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out devils."

The early Christian Communities understood clearly that it was their responsibility to carry out the mission which Jesus had entrusted to the Apostles. It is, likewise our duty, yours and mine, as baptised Christians to take up the baton. At the end of the Eucharist, we might be dismissed with a variety of reminders, eg: The Mass is ended, go in peace to love and serve the Lord, using words where needed.
