Concluding Mass of the Centenary of Salesians of Don Bosco in Australia with the Don Bosco Relic - Saturday, 30th September at 11:00am

The Feast of the Assumption of Blessed Virgin Mary
(Last Tuesday, August 15th)

Mary's words of praise of God in the Magnificat reflect a rhythm of trust and obedience that resulted in a deeper life with the Lord.

Pondering these words can help us join that rhythm. Reread Luke verses 51 - 55 and remember the times when God has kept these promises to you.

Recall those occasions when you put yourself on a throne of some sort, and God's goodness in gently "dethroning" you. What about the times he "exalted" you through a sincere compliment from a friend or through an opportunity to serve his people more fully? Just think: in both situations, God was being just as faithful to you as he was to Mary.

Through her unwavering trust in God, Mary shows us the way to heaven. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us that "when the course of her earthly life was completed, [Mary] was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body".

Her life is a constant reminder that we can trust in the Lord's promise that we too will reign, body and soul, in heaven as beloved children of God.
