

THE AWKWARD PARABLE

From the moment Jesus told us how he would reward the workers in the vineyard, the parable has not ceased to arouse disappointment and perhaps even some anger. How could Jesus possibly deal so harshly with the first lot of workers, and then reward unusually generously the late comers! To us who have grown in the age of Labour Awards, the whole concept is simply unjust, unlawful, not to be contemplated.

This is true, of course, for so long as we judge the meaning of the parable according to our values and our principles, which was precisely what his listeners did. They had forgotten the good God, father, husband and faithful friend preached by the prophets, and had turned him into a benevolent legislator who would dispense favours according to merits: so many "brownie points" would make you worthy of so many favours. With this parable, Jesus destroyed forever the self-righteous way of relating to God. The love of God is never bought, conquered or based on good works, it is received freely, "God has filled the hungry with good things, but he has sent the rich away empty." Lk1.53

The Christian community must not discriminate between the original faithful and the late comers. God's love has no limits.
