Last week's cake stall raised \$275. Thank you!

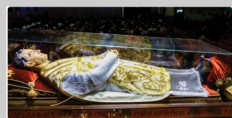

SHARING THE TRADITION

The Pope is the Bishop of Rome, a city traditionally associated with evangelisation by Peter. This Gospel text is the one traditionally used as the basis for the church's teaching on the primacy of the Pope in guiding and unifying the Church, while assisted in this task by all the bishops. There have been 267 Popes from Peter to the present pontiff, Francis. The Pope's voice is an especially privileged one in the Church. This does not mean that everything the Pope says or does is without error. What he teaches must be taken with seriousness because of the office he holds, expressing the teachings of the Church and offering an 'authoritative' guide to the faithful.
