### **WANTED: GOOD SHEPHERDS**

Among the many graffiti which have been found in the Roman catacombs there is one which depicts a man with a lamb draped across his shoulders. We have always taken this picture as a symbol of The Good Shepherd, which Jesus attributes to himself. While we have become accustomed the idea of Jesus referring to himself as shepherd, this would have caused some disquiet among his disciples. People took it for granted that a shepherd was responsible for providing milk and wool, but were reticent to forgive his dishonesty when leading his sheep on other people's pastures.

Jesus took the symbolism further by telling us that he was a GOOD shepherd, which the religious leaders would have known to have a solid foundation in Scripture. It was the prophet Ezechiel who had needed to address the leaders of his day, reminding them that they had a duty to be Good shepherds. He castigated them for failing in their duty, " You have not strengthened the weak, you have not brought back the strayed, you have not sought the lost, but with force and harshness you have ruled them." Jesus embodied all the qualities of God "the shepherd of Israel".

These days, as much as at any other time, we look to Shepherds who are Good, in the image of Jesus. Shepherds who know their people and who care for the weak, Shepherds who seek those who are lost, and who provide them all with the food of the Eucharist and the Word of God.
