## I SHALL MEET YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN

After the Resurrection, Jesus invited the disciples to meet him on **the** mountain. The fact that he did not name the mountain seems to imply that the disciples already knew it, and that was the reason why they returned to Galilee. It was, in fact the mountain of the Beatitudes. For Matthew, this mountain was significant, because it echoed the mountain where God gave the Israelites the Ten Commandments. In their original form, the Commandments were very brief and simple: Love God, Honour your father and mother, Do not kill... It had been the task of the Doctors of the Law to interpret them.

With the Beatitudes, Jesus gave the disciples (and us) **his** authoritative interpretation. It was by accepting the Beatitudes that the disciples acknowledged Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God. Matthew tells us that by "*falling on their knees,*" the disciples did actually recognise Jesus as the Son of God, "*though some hesitated.*"

A detail which could be of some comfort to us, because we too tend to hesitate at times, and ask questions. We might have wished, for God to have been more visibly present during the COVID pandemic and during the disastrous bushfires, floods and droughts! It is to all of them, including the 'doubting ones' to whom Jesus entrusts his Mission... "*go and make disciples of all nations...*" It is a Mission which is entrusted also to all of us who have accepted to follow Jesus as Son of God. We too are asked to "*teach all nations to observe the commandments I gave you.*"

In the fulfilment of the Mission, the disciples would not be left alone, for "*I will be with you always, till the end of the earth.*" For a confirmation of this 'presence,' we turn to John who in today's Gospel tells us that on Pentecost day Jesus "*breathed on them the Holy Spirit and said: Receive the Holy Spirit...*" For a more dramatic promise, we could turn to Luke who, in the Book of Acts precedes the coming of the Holy Spirit with "*the sound of powerful winds...*" thus echoing the scene on Mt Sinai. Today could be an excellent opportunity for each one of us to renew the vows which our parents made for us at our Baptism when we first received the gift of the Holy Spirit.
