**REFLECTION - TREASURE HUNT**

It might not refer to a children's egg-hunting on Easter Sunday, but it does have to do with treasures of sorts. The two individuals in the parable are both looking for a treasure, one wants to buy a field which he knows contains a treasure, while the other goes around searching for a special pearl, a very expensive one. What astounds us is that both are prepared to sell all they have in order to raise the required funds. We know well that this is not really good practice: does it mean land, home and...? Perhaps both you and I have some difficulty understanding the parable, until we look at the real meaning.

What is essential in the parable is to remember that the real prize is THE KINGDOM OF GOD. And if you don't warm to the idea of a kingdom, you could think of being face to face with God for all eternity, a situation which we readily call Heaven. We would certainly give up all we have to realise the dream which we have entertained throughout our life. But is this the only way to see this parable, or is there also another way? For another possibility, you could tune to channel SMM 6:00 pm or 9:00 am
