SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE:

CODE OF CONDUCT DECLARATION







The Safeguarding Children and Young Code of Conduct Declaration is an acknowledgement that clergy, employees and volunteers have read and understood the behavior's and conduct expected of them and agree to comply with the Code of Conduct.

Clergy, employees and volunteers are required to sign the Safeguarding Children and Young People Code of Conduct Declaration upon their commencement of working/volunteering in the Parish.

Volunteers are required to re-sign the Declaration every three years. Clergy and staff are required to re-sign the Declaration annually.

ALL parishioners who volunteer in our parish are required by the Melbourne Archdiocese to have a current WWCC and sign a Code of Conduct Declaration every three years, regardless of your role.

Verify Working With Children Check (WWCC)

- All parishioners, volunteers and staff are asked to verify that their Working With Children Check (WWCC) is still valid, (expiry date on card).
- If it is not, please renew it.
- If you do not have a WWCC please apply using the following link:-

https://service.vic.gov.au/services/working-with-children/landing

You will need photo id and a phone with camera to record your face. There are cards available at the back of the church with information on how to apply for WWCC or how to renew your current card.
