

PILLAR 4 ~ ACCOMPANIMENT

Four Pillars of Going Forth As Disciples

The Four Formation Pillars, Going Forth As Disciples (GFAD) forms Catholics to be missionary disciples of Jesus Christ.

This information is built upon four pillars:

PILLAR 1 ~ PRAYER

PILLAR 2 ~ DISCERNMENT

PILLAR 3 ~ PREPARATION

PILLAR 4 ~ ACCOMPANIMENT

Pope Francis writes:

That all Catholics should be formed in the "art of accompaniment," a ministry where Catholics seek to connect with others in spiritual friendship. As part of Going Forth As Disciples, all parishes will engage in a parish wide accompaniment ministry in their communities. This will be identified during the first year of parish participation. At the same time, all parishioners will be invited to discern how God is calling them to accompany others in what is called Two-by Two ministry. Just as Jesus sent out his disciples in ministry teams, parishioners will seek how they are sent in a similar way.

For example, it may be that parents offer spiritual accompaniment to their adult children who have left the Church, perhaps two or three people will work together to help an elderly person in their neighborhood who has no one to turn to, or a group of friends from the parish may decide to volunteer at the local food shelf. There are endless possibilities for what Two-by Two accompaniment might look like. Imagine how the community will be transformed when every Catholic is living this ministry.
