



## Excerpt: When our God reveals himself, his message is always one of freedom,<sup>7</sup>

Pope Francis has said in his 2024 Lenten message. On Thursday 1 February, two weeks out from Ash Wednesday, Pope Francis released his annual message for the Lenten season, reflecting on the gift of Christian freedom and how the desert is a time for maturing in that gift.

'In the desert, [Israel] received the "Ten Words" as a thoroughfare to freedom. We call them "commandments", in order to emphasise the strength of the love by which God shapes his people,' the Pope said. 'It is not answered straightaway; it has to mature as part of a journey. 'He encouraged people to see the desert as the place where God leads his people as a 'bridegroom'.



'Lent is the season of grace in which the desert can become once more—in the words of the prophet Hosea—the place of our first love (Hos 2:16–17) ... Like a bridegroom, the Lord draws us once more to himself, whispering words of love to our hearts.'
