A CHOIR FOR CHRISTMAS MIDNIGHT MASS

Dear Parishioners/Friends

1. It has become clear that to keep a choir going each Sunday, particularly at the 11am Mass, is no longer practical. It requires commitment to a weekly evening practice and also before the Mass. We accept that it is not realistic to expect such a commitment, even from those who would like to be

part of the Choir. But it is practical and worth asking singers to form a choir for the major celebrations of the Church at Christmas and Easter.



2. The plan, therefore, is to form a choir to support the singing at the Christmas midnight Mass- much needed with a near full house!

3. The primary role of the Choir is to lead the congregation in their musical worship prior to and during the Mass. Most of the carols will be well known and sung in unison. There will be some music items sung in four part harmony. These will be presented by the student brothers from the Priory and choristers used to singing alto, tenor and bass harmony.

Those who attend the 11 am Mass on Sunday will be aware of the valuable role of 'strong singers' and the brothers as cantors, but membership of the choir is in no way restricted to those who attend the 11am Sunday Mass. There are 'strong singers' at other masses!

CRITERIA TO PARTICIPATE

There is only one principal requirement and that is to enjoy praising God in song and being able to sing in tune!

MORE INFORMATION

Please think about being involved. I am more than willing to chat with you to provide further information and allay any concerns you may have. It is anticipated that there will be four or five evening practices.




