ANTI-POVERTY WEEK 2019

It says a lot about us when we need to devote a whole week to the tragedy of poverty.

The very word, poverty, is repugnant and yet it pervades our society and leads to hardship and destitution.

It's more than bringing good news to the poor and let the oppressed go free (Luke 4:18).

We are asked to serve people in need, whether known or unknown to us. This includes challenging views that condemn these people.

Our economy is there to prevent the all- too-obvious signs of exclusion from a just share in our "common wealth".

In 2019, Anti-Poverty Week will be held from the 13th to the 19th of October. This year the Australian Bishops have nominated the 17th October as a Day of Action on solutions to end poverty.

This year the Raise the Rate campaign led by ACOSS is the focus on 17th October.

This campaign is aimed at increasing the rate of Newstart and associated allowances by \$75 a week.

Around a million Australians are reliant on these payments



which have not been increased in real terms for more years. 25 Newstart at around \$40 a day traps many people in

poverty and many employers say it acts as brake on job search.

We can improve our social security system to lift people out of poverty and unemployment - to truly give them a new start.

Most of you will know that for years, parishioners have been dropping their spare, annoying 5 cent coins into the first collection plate. These are then
