

## "YOUR ENDURANCE WILL WIN YOU YOUR LIVES."

In today's gospel, when some were speaking about the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and gifts dedicated to God, Jesus said, "All these things that you are staring at now, the time will come when not a single stone will be left on another; everything will be destroyed." The stunned disciples raised two questions: 'When will this happen? and 'What sign will indicate

that this is about to happen?' Jesus warned them and us not to get preoccupied with times and seasons which are in the Father's authority. Only He knows the time. Yet we get only a glimpse from Jesus of the end times.



There are parts of the prophecy which relate to the disciples and the destruction of Jerusalem. catastrophe which destroys Jerusalem

will happen. There will be fearful and wondrous signs in the sky. The earth will be shaken. There will be famines and plagues. There will be numerous wars. People will be frightened. But in responding to these disasters Jesus said: 'Take care not to be deceived.3

He also gave a message to the disciples focusing on the cost of discipleship. The church will undergo persecution. The disciples would be hated by all the nations. They were to be brought before kings and rulers who would question them about their faith in Jesus. But Jesus says, "Do not be terrified." That is opportunity for them to testify their faith. They don't need to prepare for their defence, because He will give them words and a wisdom that their opponents will not be able to contradict.

Stand firm to the end, Jesus tells them. "Your endurance, will win you your lives." But, how shall we endure? Make no mistake, Jesus is not telling us that we must do this in our own strength or



by our own force of will. We endure because we have been redeemed. We endure because we have believed. We endure because we are children of God, completely dependent on God's grace alone.

Jesus' disciples - in his time and in our time too - may have to face hardship, but it is important that they endure, remain

faithful to Jesus' words and live their lives according to his teaching. They are to act as Jesus acts. The disciples are to focus on the kingdom of God, and thereafter all else will be given to them. Disciples need to standfast themselves against all that distracts them from the teaching of Jesus, who alone has the message of eternal life.
