Lunar New Year 2018, the year of the dog: Happy New Year to those who celebrate Lunar Year.





WELCOMING THE STRANGER

"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was a stranger and you made me welcome." (Mt:25: 35)



Over the last four years we have worked with and relied on **Sister Brigid at the Brigidine Asylum Seeker Resource Project (BASP)**, especially for her advice and inspiration. We are holding a special collection for food and other items at all the Masses **next weekend** to be given to the BASP. It is another way the people of St Dominic's can help vulnerable people who are seeking asylum in Australia while they await the outcome of their applications for protection.

St Dominic's parish, through the WELCOMING THE STRANGER committee, is supporting two Afghani women, who are seeking asylum in Australia, with accommodation and social support. Last year the Immigration Department issued the women with 5 year Safe Haven Enterprise Visas.

In addition, we continue to financially help St Bridget's parish Greythorn in their support for an asylum-seeker Tamil family – father, mother and three children .
