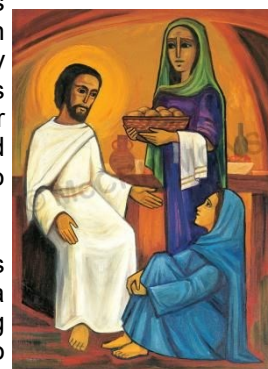

## “YOU WORRY AND FRET ABOUT SO MANY THINGS.”

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus enters the house of Martha who welcomes him hospitably. Martha has a task of preparing meal. Since Jesus comes with his disciples, she has to prepare a meal for more than a dozen of people. She has a lot going on and needs to work hard in order to show Middle Eastern hospitality to Jesus. Mary, on the other hand, is completely unhelpful in Martha's plan for hospitality. She shows hospitality toward Jesus in a different way, by listening to his every word.



Mary listens to the Lord. Martha provides a welcoming home. They both create a great sense of hospitality. But, something in the story changes. It isn't just about two good ways of hospitality. Martha is not content with the state of affairs in her home. She is pulled internally in two different directions because she is working harder than Mary. She wants Mary to do what she's doing, to be just like her. Martha is distracted because she is comparing herself to her sister.

Jesus responds to Martha, “Martha, Martha, you worry and fret about so many things, and yet few are needed, indeed only one.

It is Mary who has chosen the better part, it is not to be taken away from her.” Mary knows where she wants to be and is not divided in spirit about her decision. She recognizes that she needs to give her focus to the words of Jesus. She needs to stop doing anything else. She has chosen the better part.

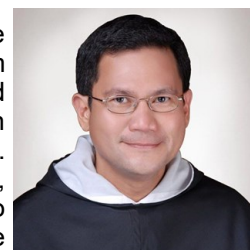


What is the one thing needed that will keep you awake, aware, open, receptive, and present to Christ? Choose that.
