You might remember that the gospel from Mark was selected for the first Sunday of Lent for us. We were told that the Spirit of the Lord "drove" Jesus into the desert, where he was tempted. That Spirit was also the energizing force that accompanied and empowered Jesus' public ministry and brought him to the gates of the Holy City to complete that ministry through his suffering and death.



That same Spirit continues to enable us to take the steps to "enter" into the places where we are called to bear witness. We might not make an entrance into a grand city with a crowd ready to greet us; but have you ever had to step up for the rights of others?

What we will discover this week is what people waving palm trees would miss – that our God is a passionate lover who reaches out to us and who offers us enduring love, made manifest in the suffering of Jesus.

Children received their first reconciliation:

Congratulations to our children who received Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time during the week. It was a special time to reflect on God's forgiving love. It was a communal service that the whole family may participate in this beautiful sacrament of forgiveness together. Parents also went to confession at this service following their children. We are reminded that unlike Baptism and Confirmation, Reconciliation is a sacrament that can be received as often as we want, since it strengthens us with grace each time it is received.

Fr Joseph Wilson: who was parish priest of St Dominic's has passed away on 16th March at age 89, at Nazareth House, Wynnum. His funeral will be at 11am on Monday, 26th March at Our Lady of Graces Church, Carina, QLD. May he rest in peace.

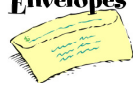

GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION The annual collection for the support of the church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land by providing welfare assistance to local Christians in areas such as health, education, employment and housing. Parishes, schools, orphanages and medical centres throughout the Holy Land also rely on assistance from the Good Friday collection. The collection is also used to maintain 74 churches and shrines associated with the life of Jesus. Last year, Australian Catholics donated \$1.35 million to this cause, despite tough economic times, rural droughts and increasing cost of living which put a strain on family budgets and financial resources.
