

a two year wait to have their appeals heard before the Federal Circuit Court – no money, no work rights. These women, men and children are dependent on charitable organizations for food, shelter and everyday living requirements. With the support of the community of St Dominic's we have and are assisting with rent and interactions with Centrelink and our annual appeal for food items has helped stock the Brigidine Asylum Seekers Project food bank.
