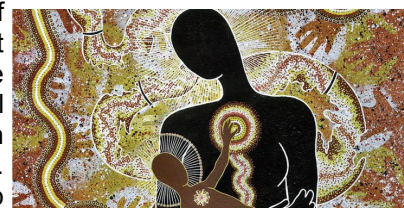

ABORIGINAL TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER SUNDAY

Because of Her, we can is the theme chosen for this year's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday. This celebration is an opportunity to recognise and express the cultural identity within the Catholic Church of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders and acknowledge their spirituality as the original custodians of the land on which we worship today. In doing so we also acknowledge that God has been walking with these peoples and making His presence known through a continuous living culture over many thousands of years.

While this theme clearly recognises Mary, who bore her Son Jesus to bring healing to the world, it also recognises the many Aboriginal women who are the backbone of communities throughout Australia; the mothers, the grandmothers, the aunties and nieces, the daughters and cousins, and the sisters. One of these women, Erica Bernard a woman of Yawuru/Gidja spirituality from Broome reflects on the ATSICC website that she easily recognises the qualities of these women reflected in Our Lady. Sadly though, she recounts a group of Aboriginal women who chose Michaelangelo's moving Pieta as their favoured image of Mary; the mother with the broken body of her son across her lap, nursed in her arms. For many of these strong aboriginal women the tragic circumstances of losing a child is all too real and all too common.

Our media regularly reports these sad deaths and for me, this Sunday is a good time to reflect on whether we, as a Catholic community, are responding sufficiently to the call of God's Spirit Sophia, she who brings healing, to make these deaths a thing of the past. What can we do to ensure that our oldest peoples are properly recognised in the constitution and given a more significant voice in Australia's governance? Erica's women found strength in their sad times by praying to Mary and her Son. Let us join our prayers to theirs so that we can be shown ways in which we can work together for a fairer and better community.
