"YOU CAN HAVE FUN WITH A SON, BUT YOU **GOTTA BE A FATHER TO A GIRL."**

Even as a child, I was annoyed by this line in Roger and Hammerstein's musical, Carousel.

Ever since the industrial revolution, there has been a problem with fathering in the West, it seems. Work took men out of the home, and so far away from the home, that they often had little time to be with their children. It wasn't their fault: it was just a necessity of life. But it meant



that the skills of fathering were not so easily passed down from father to son.

Yet fathering is important to both boys and girls. If it is true, as some psychologists say, that girls will often look instinctively for men who have the same patterns of behaviour as their dad, so boys will tend to model themselves on their father: that is how we human beings work, we are social animals and we learn behaviour by modelling.

For the Church, St Joseph is of course the model of fatherhood: and note, he was a foster-father, but no less loving for that. It is surely a reflection on the closeness and respect which Jesus had for his foster-father that he chooses the word abba, the word he would have used as a child for Joseph, as the word which he consistently uses for his Father in heaven, and which he teaches us to use in prayer.

Sometimes separation from a father cannot be helped, and we must admire mothers who face the challenge to bring up children without a father. But today is a day to remember and congratulate fathers, and to assure them of the importance of their role, and of doing it well.
