WHAT MAKES PEOPLE UNCLEAN?

In any communities, there are certain traditions and beliefs that are important to them. Those traditions and beliefs give people a sense of who they are; they define their own behaviours and the way they think other people should behave. That is what lies behind today's Gospel passage from Mark.



As usual, the Pharisees and Jesus were having a difference of opinion. The Pharisees were upset because Jesus and his disciples were not properly observing the traditions of the elders at mealtime. The Pharisees had noticed that Jesus and his disciples were not performing the ceremonial washings of their hands before they ate. To the Pharisees, Jesus and his disciples committed a "sin".

Before the Jews would eat, they washed their arms up to the elbow. The water for washing was kept in special jars and guarded to be free from any impurities. It was thought they would purify their hands from any uncleanness. Now this action had nothing to do with hygiene. It was merely a ceremonial washing, but it had become a very important tradition.

Jesus condemned such tradition that became more important than the things they represented. Jesus says, "You set aside the commandment of God to cling to human tradition." Jesus saw through their dead tradition. He realized that they were more concerned with outward things than they were with the things that really count. Their worship was vain because they exalted tradition to the status of doctrine.

Jesus cut through the superficiality of their outward observances to stress that the inside was more important than the outside. Jesus was more concerned with their heart condition than their hand condition. Jesus said: "It is from within, from men's hearts, that evil intentions emerge: fornication, theft, murder, adultery, avarice, malice, deceit, indecency, envy, slander, pride, folly. All these evil things come from within and make a man unclean."

You can wash your hands a thousand times and still have sin in your heart. It's not the outward form of the tradition that matters; it's what lies in our hearts that counts.

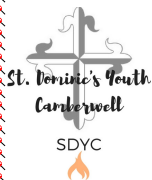
