Jesus returned to his home town and he preached in the synagogue. People were amazed by his wisdom and knowledge. They all remembered Jesus as a boy. Recognising the presence or the voice of God becomes something they struggle with.

An initial favourable response gives way to hostility. They were correct when they said he was the son of Joseph, but their prejudice

made them fail to realize that Jesus was the Son of God and God Himself. As the son of Joseph, Jesus couldn't perform miracles as the crowd expected. Jesus worked miracles because He is the Son of God, and the crowd failed to see this. Jesus saw the need for correction. What he wanted to correct in the minds of the crowd was that He is both son of Joseph and Son of God. He came to the corrupt world to make it anew. The crowd failed to see the Spirit of God who is working in Him. They wanted the son of Joseph to do some miracles in Nazareth as he did in Capernaum. They would expect Jesus to do something even more in favourable for his hometown. They did not get what they wanted and that was the beginning of the problem.

Having faith in Jesus helps us to accept Jesus as our Lord and God. However, having no faith in Jesus becomes a universal stumbling block for the finite and yet want to prove the existence of God who is the infinite.



PLENARY COUNCIL 2020

The Australian Catholic bishops have called a "Plenary Council": a meeting of all the bishops with clergy, religious and laity to Plenary Council 2020 discuss and make decisions and



recommendations on matters importance the local Church.

Because some people missed it, I enclose again today with the Dominican the explanatory flyer which was distributed last year. It includes links to the official websites, which have a wealth of further information.

The bishops would like as many Catholics as possible to respond to their question: "What do you think God is asking of us today?"

There are at least three ways to respond:

- Join in a parish gathering;
- Submit a personal response through the website;
- Write on one of the cards available at the back of the church and drop it in the box provided.

I would urge as many as possible to attend a parish gathering. This allows the preferred process of listening to God and to others - to take place in the company of fellow parishioners.

We are scheduling TWO sessions on Wednesday, 13th February, in the Parish Centre. We hope this will allow more people to participate.

- 10.00 am on Wednesday, 13th February.
- 7.30 pm on Wednesday, 13th February.

Each session will aim to be completed in no more than 90 minutes.

Please write your name on the list at the back of the church if you think to attend one of the two meetings.

Of course, you can always submit a personal response via the website or the box in the church, as well as attend a parish gathering.

The closing date for submissions is Ash Wednesday, 6th March.
