THIS IS MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE COVENANT

The gospel begins with a reference to Passover - "the Feast of Unleavened bread" and the sacrifice of the Passover lamb. That reminds us of a great intervention God did for the Jewish people.

Passover is a commemoration of liberation that God freed the Israelites from slavery in Egypt under the leadership of Moses. God helped the chosen people by inflicting ten plagues upon the Egyptians before the Pharaoh would release his Israelite slaves. The tenth and worst of the plagues was the death of the Egyptian first-born. The Israelites were instructed to mark the doorposts of their homes with the blood of a slaughtered lamb and, upon seeing this, the spirit of the Lord knew to pass over the first-born in these homes.

When the Pharaoh freed the Israelites, they left in such a hurry that they could not wait for bread dough to rise. In commemoration of Passover no leavened bread is eaten. That is why Passover was called the feast of unleavened bread.

Today's readings contain references to blood rituals in both the life of Israel and in the new covenant God sealed with us in Christ. For the Jewish people with experience of the Passover, blood signified life and so, blood was God's the author of all life. The altar is a symbol of God's presence and the 12 pillars represent the people of Israel. Blood applied to the altar was considered an



expiation from sin and a sign that the people belonged to God. The blood of sacrificed animals sprinkled on the altar, the 12 pillars and then on the people, signified that they shared a new life with God. The blood also spoke of God's commitment to the people. What then was asked of the covenanted people? They were to commit themselves to observance of the Law Moses related to them. Upon hearing what this God, who had chosen them and entered into covenant with them, asked of them, the people responded, "We will observe all the commands that the Lord has decreed."

Our response at Eucharist is similar. Jesus, the Lamb of God, has offered his blood, his life, for us. Jesus was willing to give up his life so that we might share in it and have life. Jesus chose to put his life in service to others so that we could learn a new way of living and be a people of hope. Jesus was willing to sacrifice

himself so that we could be the beneficiaries and

receive new life.

Today's celebration of Corpus Christ, the Body of Christ, is the feast of the heart of our church and our faith.

At St Dominic's we hold the care, safety and wellbeing of children and young people as a central and fundamental responsibility of our parish.


