THE GREAT COMMANDMENT OF LOVE

Jesus was often questioned and challenged concerning His interpretation of Scripture. Who is better to know the word than



the Word Himself? A scribe came up to Jesus and asked: "Which is the first of all commandments?"

EST There were hundreds of laws forming the basis for the Jew's beliefs and religious practices. There were so many laws that

they found it impossible to keep them all in daily life. They often discussed which were the most important, which must be absolutely obeyed, and which could be tolerated undone.

Jesus takes all the law and sums it up in these two great truths. He teaches that love is the greatest commandment of all. First of all, Jesus shows fidelity to their faith tradition by quoting Deuteronomy: "You shall love the Lord your God...." It was part of the daily prayer of devout Jews. But he connects this teaching with the law that commands love of neighbour.

Jesus made the two laws parallel to each other. People could not help but realize his meaning: the two were equal in importance. Would our instinct be to put love of God in first place? After all, it's God! Every other religious observance would be important, but on a lower level. But Jesus teaches we must treat the two laws as equal in importance.

The love Jesus describes asks everything of us. The first part of the teaching requires, "with All your heart, with All your soul, with All your mind, and with All your strength." This is the biblical way of summarizing the whole person. It leaves no wiggle room, and

will not allow watering down. Loving God and loving neighbour is a way of giving the full gift of ourselves in service to God. This is not an option; we are commanded to love. There is no greater commandment.



The scribe realized that real love pleased God more than

sacrifices and offerings. There is no better way to please God than to love Him and others. Simply put, without love we do not please God!
