"IT IS THE LORD"

Jesus comes to the disciples once again, and it is his third appearance after the resurrection. He appears to them when

they seem drifting back to their old business before following the call of Jesus.

Peter is going fishing suggests the disciples were unable to sustain their Easter faith. So, their belief in the resurrection



hasn't translated into life and mission. After all they have experienced in their time with Jesus, and having encountered the resurrected Christ, they seem to have forgotten his charge to them. They are not going "fishing" - going out to catch others for Christ. They are just returning to their old business, as if nothing has changed in their lives! Even Peter's tone suggests a kind of resignation, "I'm going fishing," as if to say, "What else is there to do?" Things are falling apart and the call they received seems to have dissolved. While the disciples may have abandoned their call, it is encouraging to note that Jesus has not abandoned them. As in the beginning of the Gospel, when he first called them, and after his resurrection, when he goes to them in the locked room, once again Jesus finds them and calls them to their mission. And note where he finds them (and us) - in the midst of their everyday working lives. They are at their old work and he goes there to meet them.

Peter's fishing expedition becomes a new experience of abundance, mirroring miracles of turning water into wine at Cana and the twelve baskets of food left over at the feeding of the 5,000. The nets that had been empty when used under the disciples' own power are filled almost to bursting with a word from the risen Christ, who then prepares them a meal. Once again, the disciples are eating with Jesus and one another. This "last breakfast" transforms a moment of deprivation and insufficiency into a feast, with unexpected blessing made available for all.

When the disciples had gone back to old patterns, they need renewal in their identity as witnesses to the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. Like them we need to be strengthened in our resolve to love and to bear up under the persecution that comes because we follow Jesus' call to love and service. The Eucharistic table is the place we get help and a renewal of our resolve to carry the cross, and follow Christ.
