"REMAIN IN MY LOVE"

Jesus tries to explain what true love is. The greatest love is to lay down one's life for others. Jesus is about to become the example by dying on the cross to save those who believe in Him. It is the



love of the Father who sent His onlybegotten Son to earth to die on a cross that whoever believes in Him can share everlasting life with Him.

With love, Jesus has changed status of his followers. They have been raised from slaves to friends. A slave serves out of

fear, but a friend does not fear. They are friends because Jesus has revealed all that the Father had sent Him to reveal. They now know the truth, and this truth sets the believer free.

The disciples are reminded of the basis of this new relationship. Jesus tells them that they did not choose Him, but He chose them and ordained them to produce fruit. This is a call to put down all human pride and to acknowledge the grace of God.

MAY, THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The secular world tends to put a day aside each year to celebrate the act of motherhood. It's called Mother's Day, the second Sunday in May. In the same way, the Catholic Church has traditionally set aside the entire month of May to honour the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God.

May is still part of the Easter season, the period of fifty days which lasts from Easter to Pentecost. It is a time to reflect on the joy of the Blessed Virgin Mary over her Son's resurrection and the comfort and accompany she gave to the Apostles during difficult time of the early Church.

Mary has a unique role in salvation history as the Mother of God. By her own free will she agreed to bring the "Word made flesh", our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ into the world.

Her life recorded in the Gospel was one of service and great devotion to Jesus, from the time she bore Jesus in her womb to the time she laid him in the tomb.

The feast of Saint Catherine of Siena happens yearly on 29th April. This year, it falls on Sunday. That's why there is no feast for her in the calendar of the Church. 
