"NEITHER DO I CONDEMN YOU."

In the story of Jesus and the woman taken in adultery we find two things revealed. Frist, the dangers of a judgmental spirit, and second, the forgiving heart of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus is suddenly interrupted by a group of scribes and Pharisees

surrounding an embarrassed woman. The men push their way through the crowd until they (and the woman) are standing before without Jesus and say: 'Teacher, this woman was caught in the very act of adultery, and Moses has ordered us in the Law to to throw a stone at how condemn women like this to death by stoning. What have you



to say?' The men seem to demand a hasty response or a simple "yes" or "no" answer. But there are still many questions to be

Who was the woman? We do not know.

How did these men happen to catch her "in the very act?" We don't know.

Where was the man? Adultery requires two persons. It is not likely that the man somehow escaped but the woman didn't.

Why did they expose her publicly? There was no need to do that. Why did they bring her to Jesus?

The woman in the story is merely a means to an end. She is used to trap Jesus. Is he going to agree with the law by letting people stoning her and undermining his reputation as a man with message of God's compassion and forgiveness for all, even sinners? Or will Jesus risk his religious credentials by daring to contradict the teaching of Moses?

When it comes to people's lives, things are seldom so clear-cut. In Jesus' mind, the issue is not the woman, it is her accusers. They want to talk about the Law as it relates to outward behaviour; Jesus wants to talk to them about the Law as it relates to their hearts. Jesus does not say, "Let her be stoned" but "If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to cast a stone at her."

At the end, Jesus declares: "Neither do I condemn you, go now and don't sin any more." Jesus treats her with dignity and compassion. He treats her sin with total honesty. He imparts grace and hope. He forgives her sin and sends her away to start a new life.

There is more to your life than your sin. You are worthier than you have been. You can turn away from this sin. You can have a new life.
