NATIONAL ABORIGINAL DAY OBSERVANCE COMMISSION Sunday 7 July 2019

The theme of this year's celebration centres around three words: "Voice. Treaty. Truth." These three words were key elements to the reforms set out in the Uluru Statement from the Heart, worked out at the First Nations Constitution Convention in 2017.

"VOICE" would mean having a First Nations voice enshrined in the Constitution. This could be done by legislation.

"TREATY" would mean the establishment of a Makaratta Commission. Makarrata means two parties coming together



after a struggle. The word's core message is to acknowledge that something wrong has been done and to seek to make things right, to heal past wounds and live again in

peace. The word captures the aspirations for a fair, truthful and reconciled relationship between First Nations and the people of Australia, and for a better future for First Nations' children based on justice and self-determination.

"TRUTH: would seek to bring about truth-telling in dealing with our national history.

Despite the Turnbull government having dismissed these proposals as unworkable, BHP and Rio Tinto early this year endorsed the Statement and its objectives.

Often, First Nations' peoples seem physically very distant from us. Many of us have had little or no contact with Aboriginal people, and feel quite unmoved by what they seek. Having been in Australia for more than 80,000 years, and suffered cruelly at the hands of the first white settlers, we should encourage our government to change its policy and to endorse the aims and objects of the Uluru Statement. Besides making a determined effort to pray for this change and the recognition of our first peoples, each of us can write to our Federal Member with a simple message: to ask that the Federal Government take steps immediately to implement these three key points: VOICE, TREATY, TRUTH and for it to endorse the words of the executives of BHP and Rio.


