GOD LOVES THE VULNERABLE

The question of divorce raised by the Pharisees to Jesus was not for the sake of a speculative debate. Mark tells us they were testing him. In Jesus' culture a good and permanent marriage was crucial for women, since they could not own property and had no way of earning a living on their own. So, a married woman had support, both for herself and her children.



The law against divorce then, provided protection for women and children from the whims of the dominant and strong. When the divorced wife is dismissed from the house, what protection would she and her children have?

Jesus has affirmed the ideal of marriage and has also said it is wrong for a man to divorce his wife and remarry, because it is an injustice against his dismissed wife. Thus, he teaches the equality of both husband and wife in marriage. We hear the ideal Jesus has placed before us for marriage.

Jesus' response to the Pharisees was less a discussion about the lawfulness of divorce and more about the divinely-instituted origins of marriage found in Genesis. His stance, spoken in the context of his world was one of compassion for those in need and a reaffirmation of the sanctity of marriage.

- 3) pray Rosary before midday weekday masses at 11:35am.



Focussing now on Sunday October 7 2018 –Catholics in the United States, Poland, Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Mexico, Central and South America, Canada and India will meet to pray the Rosary together for the strengthening of the family, rekindling of the Faith and continuing Godly protection for each country with each participating nation to pray for its own intentions on that day.

Let us make this week special by saying the Rosary for the well-being of our nation, our families and our pastors and religious.
