

ST DOMINIC'S IS A CHILD SAFE PARISH

At St Dominic's we hold the care, safety and wellbeing of children and young people as a central and fundamental responsibility of our parish.

LIVE BY FAITH, NOT BY SIGHT

How could Thomas accept what the other disciples were telling him, "We have seen the Lord"? What they told him made no sense at all. Thomas demanded that "Unless I see the holes that the nails made..." His declaration of faith relies on experience by touching and seeing.



The fact is Jesus did rise. His resurrection creates a whole new ballgame! Nothing would be the same – his disciples would have to view their lives and life in general, in an entirely new way. They would have to replay what they heard Jesus say, which at first sounded impossible or contradictory to them and now they would have to listen with new ears and new understanding. Things like: "Those who want to gain their life must lose it... The last shall be first, the first last... Unless a grain of wheat fall to the ground and die, it remains just a grain of wheat, but if it dies, it bears much fruit..."

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are lay people who help with the distribution of Communion during Mass and taking Communion to parishioners who resides in aged care centres, or in their own homes but unable to get to church. Those involved in taking Communion to the sick and/or aged attend 9:30am Sunday Mass and give a further 1 to 2 hours after Mass to take Communion to those unable to attend Mass. You will be rostered once every 4 weeks.



We are desperately in need of volunteers in this ministry since there are 5 Aged Care Centres (not including Nazareth House) in our parish. Candidates for this ministry are required to apply for Working With Children and Police Check (the cost is paid by Parish Office who can assist you to obtain them) as required by Diocesan policy and attend an informational session on protecting vulnerable adults.
