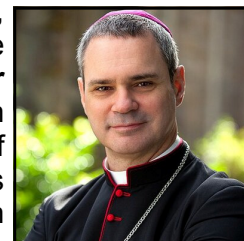

Dear parishioners,

As you read will have heard by now, Pope Francis has announced the appointment of **Bishop Peter Comensoli**, currently bishop of Broken Bay (north of Sydney) as Archbishop of Melbourne. Archbishop Hart, who has reached retirement age after seventeen years as Archbishop, will stay on as Apostolic Administrator of the archdiocese until the installation of Archbishop Comensoli on 1 August.

This week we also heard of a new bishop for Auki in the Solomon Islands. **Fr Peter Houhou** is the first Solomons-born bishop, and news of his appointment has delighted the brothers in the priory.

Last week, you will have read that I was recently elected prior – that is the superior – of the local community. I am also looking after the parish while Fr Peter is on holidays. I thought I should introduce myself briefly.



I am no stranger to St Dominic's. I was here as a novice and a student from 1976 to 1983, and as Master of Students from 2002 to 2007. (I spent eighteen years teaching high school at Blackfriars in Adelaide, and from 2009 to 2016 I was teaching in the seminary in Port Moresby. I have recently sent a year studying Canon Law in Ottawa, Canada.)

I will try to keep the parish informed about developments in the Priory. St Dominic's is really the powerhouse for our province, since it is here that our students are trained for ministry. Over the years we have benefitted enormously from the support given to us by the parish, and the opportunities the parish has provided for ministry by the students.

It's good to be back. I have already caught up with some of the "older" parishioners who remember me from the 70s; I look forward to meeting many new parishioners in the weeks ahead.
