CHILD PROTECTION SUNDAY

Child Protection Sunday concludes National Child Protection Week, and this year coincides with the release of the Catholic Church's Response to the Royal Commission into Child Abuse.

It is an apt moment to reflect on our responsibility to ensure that children in our churches and schools can grow, worship, talk and play in safety. We now know that in the past, too many trusted people in our Church were guilty of exploitation and abuse. Some who should have been protectors, became abusers, some didn't listen closely enough, and some did not react



appropriately to potential and real dangers. Child Protection Sunday gives us an opportunity to take stock and check that we have appropriate protocols in place and that they are meticulously observed, so that our Church is a place where children can flourish.

Despite a plethora of policies, Codes of Conduct, checks and protocols the media reaction when representative Church figures, even the Pope, make an apology, is an outcry of, "Not enough". People are not yet convinced that sufficient reparation has been made. The litany of complaints is a wound that has still to discover full healing. At times we are left wondering if healing will ever occur.

Today's reading from Isaiah can offer us hope. Exiled from Israel, the people had their faith tested in tough times. They were dispirited and isolated. Sound familiar? The crimes of clerical abuse have left many, and not just the personally affected, sapped of joy and confidence in living their faith. Isaiah describes vividly how it feels to be made whole again. What a change that would be for a Church where children were unsafe and abused victims unheard, to find that "the eyes of the blind opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped" so that we can all "sing for joy" again.

The deaf man in Marks's gospel is also brought out of a world of silence into one where he can hear and speak clearly. He can participate fully in the life of his community. The Church to which Jesus calls us is one where people speak freely and life is lived fully.



Let us pray that God may guide us as we strive to ensure that our communities provide a safe environment for every child. May those harmed in childhood find courage in facing the past and be led to God's healing protection.
