### "PUT OUT INTO DEEP WATER AND PAY OUT YOUR NETS FOR A CATCH."

After a long night of fishing without catching any fish, and then after a long morning of cleaning nets, Peter and his friends received

Jesus' advice about fishing, "put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch."

Pause and try to understand what Jesus was asking Peter to do here. First of all, Peter was the fisherman, Jesus was a carpenter and a teacher. Who knows more about



fishing? Peter should be instructing Jesus about how to fish, not the other way around. Second, Peter had already been fishing all night long, and he hadn't caught anything, "but if you say so, I will pay out the nets." Jesus' advice doesn't make much sense, but he would obey Jesus anyway. Sometimes, the things God wants us to do doesn't make much sense to other people, or even to ourselves. But if God has spoken to us through His Word, we should obey. This is what Peter did.

Obedience to Christ's commands always results in divine blessing. Here the blessing was boatload of fish. So many, in fact, that their nets were about to break, and they had to call their friends over to help them. But even then, the two boats were not large enough to hold all the fish. They filled both the boats to sinking point.

When God tells you to do something, do it, even if it doesn't make sense. God told Noah to build an ark because a flood was coming when nobody had ever even heard of rain. And Noah did it. God called Abraham to pack up his possessions and start walking. And Abraham did it, even though he didn't know where he was going. God wants to work through us, human beings. God wants to bless you. But you have to be like Peter who says, "That doesn't make sense, but nevertheless, at your word, I will obey." Disciples obey Jesus even when it doesn't make sense.



Peter and his friends went ashore and left everything behind to follow Jesus. We need to trust our own wisdom and knowledge, but we need to trust God more, because God is our strength when we get tired; God is our Light when we grope in darkness; God is the source of joy when we are saddened. When we don't know where to cast our nets, consult Him!

### PLENARY COUNCIL Listening and Dialogue

All parishioners are invited to participate in a "listening and dialogue" session this Wednesday, 13th February, at either 10.00am or 7.30pm. Each session is limited to 90 minutes.

The Bishops are inviting all Australian Catholics to reflect on this question:



\* What do you think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?

\* They also suggest that we might have questions about the future of the Church in Australia for the Council to consider, and that we might want to share stories or experiences to give context to these questions.

The listening and dialogue process is quite specific.

It is not a forum for debate, nor what you would usually think of as a "discussion group." It is a chance to listen, reflect and share before deciding what to submit to the Plenary Council. We will begin with a prayer, and a short silent reflection.

There will then be small groups of 4 or 5 people to consider the two questions above. We take it in turn to answer the first question; each person's response is not disagreed with, or challenged. The same goes for the second question. Someone takes notes, and condenses where possible.

Each group then chooses one topic for further reflection and sharing. Then the leaders of each group report back briefly to the whole meeting. Finally, we will end with a praver.

These points will then go forward to the Plenary Council organisers. Please remember that you are welcome to make your personal submission on the website, or on the cards at the back of the church.

It would greatly assist us with planning if you would indicate your intention to attend on the sheets near the church doors. I hope to see you on Wednesday!
