# PROCLAIM THE GOOD NEWS TO ALL CREATION

Before departing from this world to return to the Father, Jesus



gives his disciples a great commission: "Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation." Beginning with that general commission, Jesus encourages them to do mission by themselves, or rather, they are to continue the mission Jesus has started

when he calls them to follow Him. His final instructions begin with the idea that his friends and followers should share the Good News they have received with the entire world - all creation.

They are to proclaim and demonstrate the immediacy of the kingdom of God in the midst of all peoples. In response to this proclamation, they are to unite all peoples to Him through baptism. The works they do will be extraordinary because the Lord will work with the disciples and confirm their preaching with accompanying wondrous signs.

The mysterious feast of the Ascension reminds us that Christ accepts our lack of self-confidence in ourselves. He accepts the shadowy and dark areas of our humanity. He accepts our capacity for deceit, betrayal, greed and power. Having accepted us, He calls us, gives us the commission to be His people.

# MARY, MOTHER OF GOD

The Easter season is a fitting time to recall Mary's immense joy over her Son's Resurrection and to rediscover her role as mother and teacher in our lives.

Mary has a unique role in the God's plan of salvation and in the Church. She consented to the coming of the Saviour and cooperated in developing His mission. She brought Him into the world, raised Him and lovingly stood by His side during the years of His hidden life. She supported Him during His public ministry in a quiet way, beginning at Cana, where by her intercession



Jesus turned water into wine. She cooperated in His work, even uniting her own suffering with that of her Son, standing at the foot of His cross. Mary was Jesus' first disciple, humbly following Him through His journey and mission. She trusted in God completely and lived by His grace. She is our model of true discipleship and of complete faith.

During the Easter season we are more aware of Mary's motherly presence and love. It is perhaps for this reason that popular tradition has dedicated the month of May to Our Blessed Mother.




