"TODAY YOU WILL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE"

Jesus is willing to enter to Jerusalem and accept his approaching suffering and death. He could have taken another direction to avoid the city and his fate. Instead, He is willing to go to any length to free us from our prisons of sin and isolation. We again

learn what being a disciple of Jesus requires of us, as individuals and as a community, commitment and self-sacrifice. Will following Jesus stir our passion to once again take up our cross and willingly die to self in his name?



Throughout the history of the Church, there have always been people who have fallen away, lived bad lives, come to their senses and made a U-turn to God. They have appreciated God's compassion and mercy. Peter and one of the thieves have that kind of experience. After the arrest of Jesus, when Peter denies Jesus for the third time, Jesus turns and looks at him, then Peter remembers his word, "Before the cock crows today, you will deny me three times." And Peter goes out and weeps bitterly.

On the cross at Calvary, Jesus asks his Father to forgive those who are crucifying him with the words of forgiveness, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing."

One of the criminals who are hanged there keeps mocking Jesus saying, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us!" But the other rebukes him, saying, "Do you not fear God? We indeed have been condemned justly, for we are getting what we deserve for our deeds, but this man has done nothing wrong." Then he says, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." He replies, "Indeed, I promise you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Although the physical sufferings of Jesus were extreme, a cruel way of torturing a person to death, it is in the interior sufferings of Jesus that we find his deepest suffering and the meaning of his sufferings for the salvation of the world. By the self-sacrifice of Christ, we see God's love and mercy and grace manifest in His willing sacrifice.


Our God is broken for a broken people, familiar with our troubles as a friend. And Christ is wounded for the whole world's healing, our God who suffers till all sorrows end.

GOOD FRIDAY HOLY LAND COLLECTION

The Annual collection for the support of the church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday.
