“WHO IS OUR NEIGHBOUR?”

Although many people know little of the Bible or of Christianity, they know the parable of the Good Samaritan. A lawyer approached Jesus and asked Him, “Master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” This was a good and important question. Some may ask this question in order to know just how good to be to get to heaven. They may want to know exactly what they need to do to be right with God.

Jesus did not answer directly the question, but responded back to him by raising another question, “What is written in the law? What do you read there?” The lawyer answered by quoting the “Great Commandment” – “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbour as yourself.” By asking “What is written in the law?” Jesus pointed him to God’s Word. In fact, that is where we should look for answers to important questions of life. God has already revealed to us what is required for eternal life and it is written in Scriptures.

The lawyer wanted to go further by asking Jesus “who is our neighbour?” Jesus gave a concrete example by telling the parable of a man, who happened to be beaten by the brigands, who left him half-dead on the road. Both the priest and the Levite saw the victim, but neither of them helped the man. A Samaritan saw him. He anointed and bandaged the victim and took him to the inn keeper nearby. He covered the expenses, and promised to give extra on his way back from business. After telling the parable, Jesus asked the lawyer: “Which of these three, do you think, proved himself a neighbour to the man who fell into the brigands’ hands?”. The Samaritan proved to be a neighbour of the victim.

In this context, a neighbour is a stranger, a victim, whom the Samaritan met for the first time on his way to do business. He made no distinction of personal background, occupation or race. The parable didn't mean the priest, the Levite, and even the brigands, weren't qualified to be neighbours of the victim. They were all neighbours, but the Samaritan was best suited to the concept of neighbouring Jesus was teaching: 'love your neighbour as yourself'. The Samaritan loved the victim as himself. The others loved themselves more and loved the neighbour less.
