When I tell people that I was studying Canon Law in Ottawa, it is not uncommon for them to express surprise. If they even know what canon law is, they are perhaps surprised that it is still a relevant matter for study today.

In fact the Church has always needed laws – rules which govern how we Christians associate – since the earliest times. Chapter 15 of Acts of the Apostles tells of a council of bishops and elders in Jerusalem which had to determine

how the fledgling Church would deal with non-Jews, for example. In the end, a decision was agreed on, written down and promulgated: "It has seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to



us to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things: that you abstain from what has been sacrificed to idols and from blood and from what is strangled and from unchastity. If you keep yourselves from these, you will do well." You could say that was the beginning of canon law.

It is not the aim of the law to tie people down with unnecessary burdens, but to find solutions to problems which are faithful to the Lord's teaching. Everyone knows, I think, that canon law deals with marriage. Especially when a marriage has failed, the law is there to determine whether or not it was a true marriage in the first place. That can be a very important question in a person's life.

But canon law is important in other areas, too. As the numbers in many religious orders have dropped, it has provided a means of ensuring that schools, hospitals and the like continue not only as Catholic institutions, but as

institutions imbued with the spirit and charism of the congregation which founded them.

The choice of a new bishop, the relationship between an order and the parish entrusted to it, the rights of

individuals who volunteer or are employed by the Church, the rules for the celebration of Mass and the Sacraments – all of these and many other activities have their canonical dimension.

I found it a fascinating study, and hope that I will be better able to assist both the Order and the people we serve for having undertaken it.


