CATHOLIC SOCIAL SERVICE SUNDAY

"The mission of Catholic Social Services Victoria is to assist the Catholic Church in Victoria to fulfil the gospel imperatives to stand with and serve the poor, disadvantaged and marginalised; and work for a just, equitable and compassionate society."

This straight-forward statement of the mission of the CSSV could not be clearer, could it? You may think that the Catholic Church through its parishes which have many resources is doing a great deal to alleviate the situation of the poor, disadvantaged and marginalized. In some places that is true. However, the situation in other places is not as clear. And it is here that CSSV steps in, helping Catholic people all over Victoria see and respond to situations where they can. If we can't be on the front line, we can assist with a good donation to help the on-the-button causes with which they are engaged.

It was good for me to look at the CSSV website (<https://www.css.org.au/>) and realize the ways in which CSSV is encouraging individuals and parishes to widen their boundaries and to receive assistance in opening up new ways of helping people in need within our society. For example, they are sponsoring forums for parishes in helping them come to see how to put into practice the ideas which Pope Francis encourages us to undertake concerning the environment in *Laudato Si*. There is to be a forum which will prepare now for next winter in helping the more than "1,100 homeless people including women, children, young and older people and people with disabilities who on any night, each winter, across Victoria "sleep rough" in city parks, car parks, bushland areas and coastal reserves. This upcoming parish forum, 'Homelessness: Preparing for 2020' on Tuesday 24 September 2019 will bring together people to begin to prepare for next Winter, and to make the connections with other parishes, churches and groups that will make next year's Winter Shelter a success in as many areas as can be reached." This is a practical idea for us too, as in each of the parks in the catchment area of St Dominic's we know that there are homeless people living and sleeping rough.

I encourage you to look at the website, and take part in the great work which CSSV is doing; and to make a donation to their work. Remember Jesus' words: "In do far as you did this to the least of these sisters and brothers of mine, you did it to me."

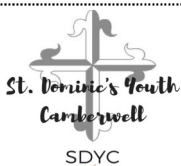

PARISHES COOPERATING TO PROVIDE WINTER SHELTER FORUM

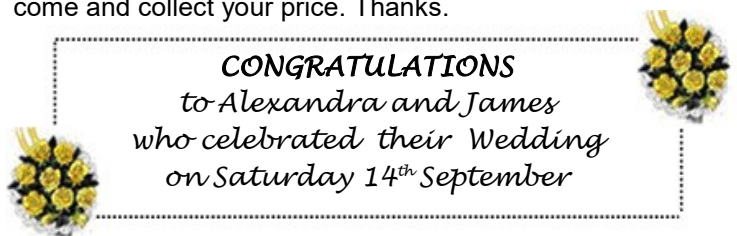
