LOSE LIFE TO SAVE IT

Jesus said, "For anyone who wants to save his life will lose it, but anyone who loses his life for my sake and for the sake of the gospel, will save it." That is Jesus' paradoxical thinking. His

saying seems to disturb common sense, and challenges our most basic instincts, including our survival nature.

Actually, it is Jesus' call for faith, putting our trust in God's grace and having hope in God's abundant life. This is long life call and it is just the



beginning of his teaching as gospel recorded: "And he began to teach them." His teaching is not only a matter of words but also conviction of changing our life. Peter knows the word of "Christ" but, until the passion of Christ begins, he fails to understand what it means for Jesus to be the Christ, the anointed one. He has to lean its meaning until he too carries his cross.

Jesus has called Peter and then works in him by His grace. It is up to Peter to lose his life in Jesus' purposes. It is to take up his cross and follow Him. We realize that this is not one time event. It is a continual process.

Sunday October 7th: Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary this year falls on Sunday October 7. Most of us are familiar with the tradition that goes back many centuries, about the connection of St. Dominic with the beginnings of the Rosary devotion. To make this day and its week special, our parish will

- 1) host the Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima from Saturday 6 October to Friday 12 October 2018.
- 2) be part of a world-wide chain of praying the Rosary.
- 3) adore the Blessed Sacrament throughout the afternoon (after 11am Mass till 5pm), ended with Benediction; Praying the Rosary at the beginning of each hour).



Focussing now on Sunday October 7 2018 – Catholics in the United States, Poland, Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Mexico, Central and South America, Canada and India will meet to pray the Rosary together for the strengthening of the family, rekindling of the Faith and continuing Godly protection for each country with each participating nation to pray for its own intentions on that day.

Participants will gather to say the Rosary for the well-being of our nation, our families and our pastors and religious.
