There is a link between events of Jesus' baptism and his transfiguration. At both events there are voices from heaven confirming Jesus' position in relation with God the Father – his identity as God's own beloved Son. At Jesus' baptism, a voice came from heaven saying, "You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you." At the Transfiguration of Jesus, a voice came from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, the Chosen One. Listen to him". With the command "Listen to him", the Father insists that the disciples, which of course today means us, should listen to Jesus.



At the Transfiguration, Jesus was speaking to Moses and Elijah about his forthcoming death which He was to accomplish in Jerusalem. The voice of the Father tells the disciples to listen to Jesus. The Father instructs them to accept what Jesus has told them, and will continue to tell them, over and over again about the suffering, the scandal and the sorrow that lie ahead for him, and therefore also for them. It was almost impossible for the disciples to understand that the suffering and death of Jesus were chosen in God's plan, and that somehow that suffering and death would make possible the forgiveness of sins. That is why John the Baptist introduced Jesus to the people by saying, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world".

The voice of God takes centre stage at the transfiguration, not only revealing Jesus' identity as the Son of God, but also commanding the disciples to listen to Jesus. The disciples must come down the mountain and follow Jesus on what will be the hard road of trials and suffering. They ponder what they had heard. They have more time to travel with Jesus; time to listen to his teaching; time to experience his passion and death; time to be transformed by his resurrection.

The listening process has begun for them. At first, they will not get it right, but Jesus will not abandon them and eventually, they will come to understand what being a disciple of Jesus means. Then they will be the ones who will undergo a transfiguration; they will be changed and become obedient to what Jesus has been telling them – they will take up the cross and follow him.



The glimpse of the transfigured Jesus in his glory is God's way of giving the disciples, which includes us nowadays, strength and courage to face realities of trials, suffering and death.

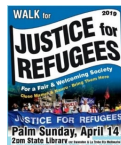
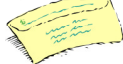


RECONCILIATION PARENT/STUDENT WORKSHOP will be held in the Church on Thursday **28th March** at 7.00pm.
