THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS LIKE

Jesus introduces today's parables by saying, "This is what the kingdom of God is like...." Then he tells his parables. Notice that Jesus is speaking about actions when he wants to describe the kingdom of God. It's not about a territory or a place. It's not about the afterlife in heaven. It's about God acting in the here and now and the parables are clues to how and where to look.



In describing "how it is with the kingdom of God," why doesn't Jesus give a formula or definition. If he had, he would have restricted or confined "how it is with the kingdom of God." Instead, by using parables, he taps into our imaginations to help us discover the surprising places and ways our God is acting.

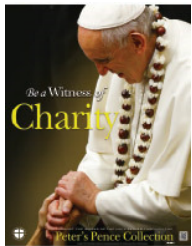


ST DOMINIC'S IS A CHILD SAFE PARISH
