"LOVE ONE ANOTHER"

Today's Gospel is a part of Jesus' farewell speech to his disciples. It takes place on the night before his crucifixion, and



he is giving his disciples final instructions for continuing his work. Since it is his very last night with the disciples, Jesus tends to teach them important issues about humility, acceptance and love.

Judas' departure begins the process by which he will betray Jesus to the authorities. His departure serves a backdrop for the glory and indicates a new

phase of life. "Now has the Son of Man been glorified, and in him God has been glorified". The Son of Man, in demonstrating such all-embracing and all-powerful love, is the manifestation and the reality of the very love of God. This reality of God's love is expressed by the Son of Man, who came not to condemn the world but to save it. Jesus is glorified by God. Jesus knows that Judas' actions will lead to his death, but that will result in victory over sin and death. The disciples don't realize it even though Jesus has told them several times that he will die and rise again.

Jesus is the source of comfort and strength for the disciples, and he knows that they must learn to support one another after he returns to heaven. That is one reason why he issues the commandment to love one another. It is also the new commandment that we as his modern disciples are to follow.

"Love one another just as I have loved you". Jesus is a clear model of the love he requires, and he proves that by washing the disciples' feet. The commandment focuses on the Christian community. We are called on to love everyone - friends, enemies and total strangers. This new commandment is open

ended. There is no end to the requirement, so we can never say that we have obeyed it entirely.

When we love as Jesus has loved us by total commitment to any and all children of God - we make



God's love visible. We show ourselves to be Jesus' representatives on earth - his disciples. This is the love that demands action, and if our actions mirror those of Jesus, as disciples we make his love visible in our own world.
