“THE WATER HAD TURNED INTO WINE”

Weddings were extremely important in Jewish society. They were not only great social events, but also an express of their understanding of God's relationship with Israel. There was a wedding in Cana of Galilee. Mary and Jesus were there as invited guests along with His disciples.



A problem happened at the wedding - they ran out of wine. This was not a minor inconvenience. For the Jews, wine was a symbol of God's blessing and was part of any joyous celebration. It became a serious problem. The reason for the lack is not important. Correcting the problem is what is important.

Jesus gives directions to the servants, “Fill the jars with water.” And they filled them up to the brim. They were filled to the brim with no room for anything to be added. When water was given to the steward, it had turned into wine. He was surprised by the good wine he was given. He did not know where the wine had come from, but he is very impressed by it. Jesus had performed a miracle.

It's clear that John is not just telling us about Jesus' providing an abundance of wine for a newly married couple's wedding in Cana. This little domestic scene signals the much larger memory of Israel's relationship with God. God is taking the initiative to permanently take a people to God's self. So a wedding is an appropriate place to announce Jesus' public entrance into the life of Israel.

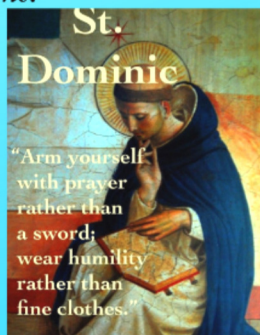
