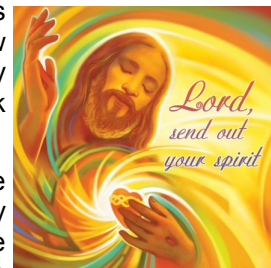

CAR PARK RESURFACING The car park behind the church is going to be resurfaced soon. This will involve the laying of a new coat of asphalt over the entire surface of the car park. We don't have the dates when the work will be done as yet, but we will advise as soon as the dates are finalised. It will only take 2 or 3 days to complete the work, and then it can be driven on almost immediately. The line marking cannot be done immediately as it needs to wait a couple of weeks for the asphalt to settle. While this is happening the car park will be open, but parishioners who choose to use the car park will need to exercise great care when parking as there will not be any line markings.
